To represent Italy in Estonia is a great honour and a responsibility, both of which I am fully aware.

Between Italy and Estonia there is commonality of ideals, shared values of freedom, community of action in the defence of peace and common security.

The European option is the basic reference for my country's foreign policy and the same is true for the Atlantic option. The construction of the political Europe, in addition to the economic one, is Italy's primary objective.
